# Hit Paris 2008: the European Congress of Health Information Systems

Hit Paris 2008, the European Congress of Health Information Systems, will take place from 27 to 30 May 2008 as part of HOPITAL EXPO-INTERMEDICA 2008.

Spread over 4 days, the Congress will bring together 1500 health professionals involved in the modernisation of the health information system, and will focus on a programme of 45 training sessions drawn up under the aegis of a steering committee and a multidisciplinary scientific committee.

## ■ THREE MAJOR SUBJECT AREAS

### 1. Health care processes and ICT

#### **Organising health care continuity**

The challenge of health care continuity: transmission of information and sharing of data.

Identification of the patient in the health care process.

Close-up on patient care: emergencies, multidisciplinary consultation meetings, networks of chronic pathologies, anaesthesia, etc.

Health care continuity outside the establishment (and the its IS).

#### **The instruments of health care continuity**

Patient's medical file, professional files (one patient, how many files?). Reference systems for good practices. Infrastructures. Directories. Standardisation and interoperability.

#### **Human resources and facilities planning**

Prescriptions and results of examinations. Management of appointments.

Management of technical platforms. HR Management

### 2. Performance and operational coordination of organisations (establishments and units)

#### **Strategies and methods**

Master plan, urbanisation: good practices. Solutions for strong project management. Accompanying change.

#### **IS solutions to budgetary and financial challenges**

IS development under the impact of the LAM/2TA reforms (laws governing health insurance and pricing).

Optimised data collection: objective -- 100% of activity invoiced.

Project decision making. Business intelligence: expectations of *EDS* and state of supply.

#### **Measuring performance**

Which indicators for which deciders? The ROI of an IS project. IS and *EDS* accreditation. Strategic and operational coordination tools: methodological (BSC) and technological.
